The May 20, 2021 meeting of the Yarmouth Conservation Commission is about to be convened. Commissioner Huggins stated that they should focus on what the shoreline is becoming; should follow the recommendations of the report and the CA. Chairman Hoopes suggested the following plan changes:

- Update elevations/MHW
- Remove turf lawn behind and in front
- Move wall back to match shoreline to create more space in front of wall
- Shorten wall to protect house only
- Dune recommended in front of garage for protection
