



**Board of Selectmen

March 27, 2012**

The meeting was called to order at 6:00p.m. by Chairman Erik Tolley. Selectmen present: Jim Quirk, Tracy Post and Curt Sears. Absent: Suzanne McAuliffe. Also Attending: Town Administrator William G. Hinchey. The Board of Selectmen gave the pledge of allegiance.

**Public**

1. Revenue Team – Grays Beach Boardwalk

*Represented by Mona Solmonte and Liz Hartsgrove who are announcing the Engraved Boardwalk plank program, the fees and the schedule of installment.*

*Norm Holcomb handed out a memo to the Board of Selectmen. Mr. Holcomb did not feel that the Capitan's village residents are being represented appropriately with the Yarmouth Housing Authority Forest Road affordable housing project.*

*Vida Morris asked when there will be an update on the renaming of the Bass River Bridge. Mr. Tolley said that it is being worked on. Ms. Morris asked if the Town was involved in promoting the town to College students as a spring break destination. The Board was unaware of any promotion. Ms. Morris asked what streets would be swept. Mr. Hinchey said that the list of streets depends on the decision of the DPW.*

1. Article 25 – Hotel/Motel Cap [Karen Greene]

The Planning Board held a workshop meeting with Hotel/Motel owners on February 22<sup>nd</sup> to get some input. The response at that meeting from the Chamber of Commerce was 50/50. A posted public meeting was held on March 21<sup>st</sup>. After discussion, the Planning Board voted to remove the cap. Karen Green reviewed the memo from Peter Johnson-Staub and the Motel Team regarding the pros and cons of removing the cap.*


