Item 1 - Collective Bargaining Strategy for Steelworkers Union

MOTION: To move that the Board of Selectmen counteroffer to the union a choice of two of the three items that follow: 1) 2% COLA in FY15 vs. 1% COLA plus 1% bonus, 2) Overtime increase on holidays (Christmas, New Year's Day and 4th of July) and 3) sick days relinquished (3) do not go to the sick bank after the first year.
